



WARNING

- Never open more than one drawer at a time.
- The use of tip-over restraints may reduce but not eliminate the risk of tip-over.

Let's get started...

Helpful hints, read before beginning assembly

- Make sure you receive all boxes. If your item is packed in one box, box count will read 1 of 1, likewise if your item is packed in two boxes, box count will read 1 of 2 and second box will read 2 of 2.
- Read each step carefully. It is very important that each step is performed in the correct order. If these steps are not followed in sequence, assembly difficulties will occur.
- Work in a spacious level area, preferably carpet, near the place the unit will be used.
- DO NO USE power tools to assemble your furniture, it will strip and damage parts.
- Your package should include the following hardware and parts. Parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge. Please inspect contents to ensure you have received all components. If you are missing any hardware or parts please contact customer service right away before assembly.



Product Care and Maintenance

- Wipe clean with dry soft cloth, never use chemicals or cleaning products that will damage the finish.
- Avoid placing your furniture in direct sunlight, as sunlight causes fading.
- Never push, drag or pull your furniture, to move to a new location carefully with two or more people carry the unit to its new location.
- Avoid extreme changes in temperature by arranging furniture away from radiators, heat and air vents and air conditioning units.









- 1. Before you throw the package, please use the Check Box to identify the parts and hardware to ensure that you have everything you need.






The Breakdown...




In hardware list, you will find seven bundles of drawer slide (H), here you need to differentiate left and right as shown in picture below.




Step 1


Insert PVC dowel (A) to panel 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,12 and 14's non-thru holes as shown, using hammer to gently tap them in.

Non-thru holes (are small indents in the wood that show you where the screws should be.)










Step 4

*Place and fix panel 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 onto panel 1 by inserting the (Left) dowels onto the non-thru holes at panel 1 by slightly tapping them in with hammer.


*Insert and fasten screw (C) (Using predrilled holes on panel 1) into the panel 4,5,6,7 and 8 by using screwdriver.



Step 5

*Place and fix panel 3 onto panel 4 and 5 by inserting the dowels onto the non-thru holes at panel 3.

*Fasten screw (C) from under the panel 4 and 5 using predrilled holes and tighten it into panel 3.



*Place and fix panel 4,5,6,7 and 8 onto panel 2 by inserting the (Right) dowels onto the non-thru holes at panel 2, then slightly hammer it in from outside of panel 2.

*Fasten screw (C) from the outside of panel 2 by using the predrilled holes to attach panel 4,5,6,7 and 8.

Step 6


*First prepare panel 9.

*Place minifix (B) long piece onto the holes of panel 9. (You will use 6 pcs) *Then place lock stopper (J) onto the bottom of panel 9, using screw (D).

*Fix panel 9 onto panel 1, 2 and 3 align properly by inserting the 6 dowels of panel 1 and 2 onto the non-thru holes of panel 9. (Slightly hammer all in)

*Gently tap the panel 9 to connect panel 1, panel 2 and panel 3 firmly.


*Tighten minifix (B) clockwise to lock minifix up by going under panel 9 and tighten it upon both sides and middle pieces (Panel1, 2, and 3).



Step 7


*Fix approximately 40 pieces of nails (I) into panel 10 using a hammer.


*Cover all the screws (C)' head with sticker (F) provided by stick up onto hole of screw (C)' heads one by one.



Step 8

Assembly Of Big Drawer : 5 Drawers







*Place panel 13 on each side of panel 12 and 14 as shown.


*Then, tighten screw (C) to panel 14 's upper thru holes to fix them onto panel 13. *Next tighten screw (C) to panel 12 's upper thru holes to fix up to the panel 13.

*Tighten screw (C) to panel 13 upper thru holes to fix up to the panel 15.







Place the "L" shaped drawer slide (H) with the small white roller facing outward and should be in parallel with drawer front panel 11. Then tighten 3 screws (D) on each drawer slide (H).



Step 9

Assembly Of Small Drawer : 2 Drawers







*Insert the minifix (B)(nuts) with the cross arrow mark facing upwards and aim to panel 12 and 14 's top thru holes.(As shown)

*Slide in panel 16 into panel 12 and 14,slightly hammer panel 12 and 14 into panels 17 and 18.


*Place panel 20 on each side of panel 12 and 14 as shown.

*Then, tighten screw (C) to panel 12's and 14's upper thru holes to fix them onto panel 20.






Place the "L" shaped drawer slide (H) with the small white roller facing outward and should be in parallel with drawer front panel 17 and 18. Then tighten 3 screws (D) on each drawer slide (H).



Step 10

*Take all drawers, and slide them (the white rollers at drawer slide at both side of drawers are to go into the track of the slide at each side panel.)All the way gently, one drawer by one drawer starting from bottom to the top accordingly.






FITTING OF ANTI-TIP SAFETY STRAP
