


Let's get started...

Helpful hints, read before beginning assembly

- Make sure you receive all boxes. If your item is packed in one box, box count will read 1 of 1, likewise if your item is packed in two boxes, box count will read 1 of 2 and second box will read 2 of 2.
- Read each step carefully. It is very important that each step is performed in the correct order. If these steps are not followed in sequence, assembly difficulties will occur.
- Work in a spacious level area, preferably carpet, near the place the unit will be used.
- DO NO USE power tools to assemble your furniture, it will strip and damage parts.
- Your package should include the following hardware and parts. Parts are labeled or stamped on the raw edge. Please inspect contents to ensure you have received all components. If you are missing any hardware or parts please contact customer service right away before assembly.




Product Care and Maintenance

- Wipe clean with dry soft cloth, never use chemicals or cleaning products they will damage the finish.

- Never push, drag or pull your furniture, to move to a new location carefully with two or more people carry the unit to its new location.
- Avoid extreme changes in temperature by arranging furniture away from radiators, heat and air vents and air conditioning units.







- 1. Before you throw the package, please use the Check Box to identify the parts and hardware to ensure that you have everything you need.

- 3. Do not completely tighten all hardware until the entire assembly is complete, unless indicated otherwise.


















Assembly Of Small Drawers : 2 DRAWERS

-Place panel Q and panel R on each side of panel N & O as shown. -Then, tighten screw (2) to panel Q and panel R 's lower thru holes to fix them onto panel N & O.


-Next tighten screw 2 to panel Q and panel R 's upper thru holes to fix up to the panel S.







-Flip drawer over with bottom side down, disassemble the lock ${
m l}$ into 5 parts as shown, then install the lock ${
m l}$ by inserting the lock 1 's cylinder into middle thru hole of panel N & O, then fix the lock up. -Tighten 2 screw ④ from inner side of panel N & O into the handle ④ holes.

Assembly Of Big Drawers : 5 DRAWERS




















-Place panel Q and panel R on each side of panel P as shown. -Then, tighten screw (2) to panel Q and panel R's lower thru holes to fix them onto panel P. -Next tighten screw (2) to panel Q and panel R's upper thru holes to fix up to the panel U.

-Flip drawer with bottom side up, place panel V onto the drawer and align properly. Then nail the nails provided with hammer on the

border of panel V as shown.The gap between 2 nails should be about 100mm.

-After that, place a drawer slide B 5 with the small white roller facing outward and with other end tip touching panel P onto

each bottom side

(angle) edge of panel R

and panel Q. Then tighten 3 screws ③ on each drawer slide B ⑤ (as shown).

-Put drawer supporting W onto middle of panel

V, then tighten screw ② to drawer supporting W 's thru hole to fix it onto panel V / panel P




-Flip the drawer over. -Tighten 2 screw ④ from inner side of panel P into the handle ④ holes.

Step 1

- * Fix Panel B onto Panel $C\,$ by inserting the dowel onto the non-thru holes at Panel C as shown.
- * Fix Panel B, C, D, E, F, G onto Panel A by inserting the (Left) dowels onto the non-thru holes at Panel A.
- * Using allen key B to tighten screw 1 from the 6 thru holes of panel f A.






CAUTIONS : When inserting the PVC Dowels to non-thru holes, don't push to hard. Otherwise, the side panels (A, I & K) may be damaged.

Step 2

* Fix Panel B,C,D,E,F,G onto Panel I by inserting the (Right) dowels onto the non-thru holes at Panel I. *Place Panel H (with drawer slide A () downward and the small white roller facing frontward) onto panel G and panel F by inserting the (down) dowels onto non-thru holes at bottom area of panel H. Using allen key (8) to tighten the 2 screw (1) from the middle thru hole of panel G and Panel F. * Using allen key (8) to tighten screw (1) from the 4 thru holes of panel H.


Step 3

 \star Fix Panel J onto Panel I by inserting the (Left) dowels onto the non-thru holes at Panel I_{\cdot}


* Using allen key 8 to tighten screw 1 from the 2 thru holes of panel \emph{I} .

* Fix panel K onto panel J, B and C by inserting the (right) dowel onto the non-thru hole at panel K.

* Using allen key 8 to tighten screw 2 from 4 thru holes of panel K.






- * Lay the chest at face down position, Place the 3 back Panels M onto the back of the main unit, and join the 2 panel M togather with H-profile by slotting one side each of panel M into the track of H-profile. Then align them properly for nailing.
- * Then use hammer to nail the nails one by one and at center of 4 side edges. Gap between 2 nails should be about 100mm for all.




* Lift up the main unit carefully and let it stand up properly.

 * Cover all the screw (1) 's head with the pvc cap provided by pushing the cover's stem onto the hole of screw head one by one for all screws.




Step 7

* Insert Hinges 1 into door panel X 's non-thru hole as shown, then tighten screw 3 through hinges 1 's thru hole.




Step 8

 * You can align the door panel X by tightening and losening the screw as shown.

Completion

* Take all drawers (5 big and 2 small), and slide them (the white rollers at drawer slide at both side of drawers are to go into the track of the slides at each side panel.) all the way gently, one drawer by one drawer starting from bottom one.
